Philippians 1:27–2:4 (ESV)

Only let your **manner of life** be **worthy of the gospel** of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel, and **NOT FRIGHTENED** in anything by your **opponents**. This is a clear sign to them of their destruction, but of your salvation, and that from God. For it has been granted to you that for the sake of Christ you should not only believe in him but also suffer for his sake, **engaged in the same conflict** that you saw I had and now hear that I still have.



So if there is any **encouragement [consolation]** in Christ, any **comfort** from love, any **participation** in the **Spirit**, any **affection** and **sympathy**, complete my **joy** by being of the **same mind**, having the **same love**, being in **full accord** and of **one mind**. Do nothing from **selfish ambition** or **conceit**, but **in humility** count **others more significant** than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the **interests of others**.
